Zero Tolerance

As a low level player (yes, I still have fewer than 299 points!) I expect the higher ranked players to be occasionally impatient when they have to explain a bid or when I ask if that was 2 over 1.

I have often thought if I was a better player, they would not be so impatient. But having talked to directors, I now know that sometimes that behavior crosses the line.

On one occasion I was playing and asked for an explanation, and when the hand was complete I realized I was given an incorrect explanation, and the partner had not corrected it prior to my lead. When I said that the opponent did not correct the explanation, I was told that I was not going to get another trick, so it did not matter. I am not sure if I would have gotten another trick, but I am sure that I would have led a different card. I mentioned that to a director later, and he said I should have called him.

Zero Tolerance means just that. The following are some examples of behavior which will not be tolerated:

• Badgering, rudeness, insinuations, intimidations, profanity, threats or violence. • Negative comments concerning opponents' or partners' play or bidding.

· Constant and gratuitous lessons or analysis at the table.

• Loud and disruptive arguing with a director's ruling.

The directors absolutely want you to call them if you have any questions or feel that someone has said something inappropriate. We all want to feel comfortable when we play.
