Virtual Games - Tips and Hints



As you can see by the smile on Joyce Haley's face, she is enjoying playing at home but hopes to get back to the bridge club soon.

Many of our RI members are playing in these games on Bridge Base Online (BBO). www.bridgebase.com

An easy way to get started is to play in the free 'Robot' games, which are offered at all times except between 11 am - 4 pm Eastern.

Once you've tried those, you can move up to BBO, ACBL, and club Virtual Games. Both ACBL and Club games offer ACBL points if you place high enough after the game.

To get started, think of several possible names (User ID) and a password.

- **1.** To create a BBO account, visit www.bridgebase.com and click Login/Register (upper right corner). Then, click "Become a member (free)". [Screens may vary on a smart phone.]
- 2. Under "PLAY OR WATCH BRIDGE", click on "Solitaire", then click on "Just Play Bridge (Free)". You can play and practice online as long as you wish.
- 3. Click on the blue "HOME" button at the top of your screen to go back to the main BBO page.
- 4. Under "FEATURED AREAS", click on "ACBL World". Here you will see "UPDATE YOUR ACBL NUMBER" should you wish to add/change it.
- 5. Back on Main Page under "FEATURED AREAS", you can click on "Virtual Clubs" to play on RI club games.
- 6. Click on the "BB\$" button to add \$\$ to your account. BBO dollars are needed to pay entry fees for pay tournaments on the site. Most tournaments are free, but if you wish to play games that issue masterpoints, you will need BB\$ to pay the entry fee.

Currently, RI Games are offered by Northern RI (Clint's Game) <u>www.bridgeclubofnorthernri.com</u>, the Viking Bridge Club (Pairs Viking Bridge) <u>www.vikingbridgeclub.com</u>, and Barton Buffington at The Bridge Place (call 401-390-9244).


